Memorize/Reflect: *“My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires.”* (James 1:19-20)

Prayer Direction: Pray for God to grow your awareness of the three areas that James instructs us to take note of: Quick to Listen, Slow to Speak, Slow to Become Angry. Thank God that these areas are opportunities to grow you in maturity and faith.

“Live It!” Challenge: 1 Quick and 2 Slow’s - Author Daniel Goleman, found that 80 percent of people who lose their job don’t do so because of incompetence. It’s because they don’t know how to effectively relate to people around them. The book of James addresses three foundational truths that can reduce the possibility of that scenario down to zero. In James 1:19-20, he lays out how we can balance the partnership between our Faith and Action:

Be quick to listen
Be slow to speak
Be slow to anger
