Memorize/Reflect: *"I will send my messenger, who will prepare the way before me. Then suddenly the Lord you are seeking will come to his temple; the messenger of the covenant, whom you desire, will come," says the Lord Almighty. (Malachi 3:1)*

Prayer Direction: Thank God for His faithfulness and goodness. Praise His name and His sovereignty. Ask God to reveal any areas in your life that may not be honoring to Him or bring Him glory and ask for His forgiveness and power to make the changes that are needed. Also ask Him to give you the strength and endurance to sustain you even though your circumstances may be challenging or seem to be hopeless. Thank Him for the gift of Jesus and the hope and healing that only He offers when we place our faith in Him.

"Live It!" Challenge: Am I giving God my best? Ask yourself in the areas of worship, relationships, service and generosity towards God and others, is God getting my best? What may be preventing me from doing so? Also, are there areas in my life that may be displeasing to God and what are one or two steps I can take this week to make changes, if necessary?
